

## MULTIPURPOSE RESIDENT GRANTS

### Mid-America Orthopaedic Association



Three grants of \$6,000 each are available for eligible individuals\* on a competitive basis for a variety of possible uses.

The grant may be used to fund a "visiting residency", educational trip abroad, research project, or any other educational activity which the resident might wish to propose (interview travel requests are not eligible for this award). A list of the programs participating in the visiting residencies may be obtained from the Mid-America office (address below).

Residents receiving awards must use the funds within the academic year in which it is awarded and will be invited to the first Mid-America Orthopaedic Association annual meeting after the project is completed. He/she will be introduced to the membership and asked to describe his/her experience with a brief illustrated presentation.

Research grants are disbursed to the Orthopedic Department or a designated official within it. Due to the size of these grants, no indirect costs should be included in the budget.

Please be advised that these funds may be considered taxable income. It is recommended that a tax accountant be consulted on this matter.

The deadline for application submission is **July 1, 2020**. Apply online via the MAOA web site ([www.maoa.org](http://www.maoa.org)).
