2010-2011 TRAVELING FELLOWSHIP

1. One Traveling Fellowship up to a maximum of \$10,000 will be awarded.
2. Applicant must submit:
 - a. Letter of intent with specifics concerning the goals of fellowship, where it will be served, with whom, and the expected benefits to you and your institution. Fellowship must be done at an institution in the MAOA 20-state area.
 - b. Copy of curriculum vitae
 - c. Two reference letters--one from your current Department Chair and another from a colleague that knows you well
3. Criteria:
 - a. Applicant must be under age 40 by date of application deadline (**July 1, 2010**).
 - b. Applicant must be a United States citizen or have applied for U.S. citizenship.
 - c. Applicant must be Board-certified or have completed an approved orthopedic residency.
 - d. Applicant must maintain a practice or be currently located in, but need not confine travel to, these states:
Alabama, Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, or Wisconsin.
 - e. If selected, recipient is expected to submit a written report after completion of the fellowship and attend the next annual meeting to give a brief report to the Association. The annual meeting registration will be waived for the recipient and spouse.

Please be advised that these funds may be considered taxable income. It is recommended that a tax accountant be consulted on this matter.

Application deadline is **July 1, 2010**. Submit letter of intent, curriculum vitae, and reference letters to:
