1. **\$2,500 Education Grants are available for senior residents\* or fellows to attend the Mid-America Orthopaedic Association 2012 Annual Meeting.**
2. **Criteria for application. Applicant must:**
  - a. Be a fellow or in last two years of residency at time of 2012 Annual Meeting (April 18-22)
  - b. Be involved in an ABOS approved residency program in one of the following states: Alabama, Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, or Wisconsin
  - c. Be a United States citizen or have applied for U.S. citizenship
  - d. Recipient must attend the MAOA annual meeting and the April 18, 2012, "Comprehensive Knee" pre-meeting course to receive the award. If the recipient is unable to attend the Wednesday, April 18 pre-meeting course, the grant dollar amount will be reduced by \$500.
  - e. Possess strong ethical and moral standards and have the potential to be a contributing member of the Mid-America Orthopaedic Association
  - f. Former recipients of education grants to attend MAOA annual meetings are not eligible
3. **Applicant must submit:**
  - a. A completed application form
  - b. A letter of intent specifying the goals of attendance at the annual meeting and the expected benefits to be realized by the applicant and his/her institution
  - c. A curriculum vitae
  - d. A letter of reference from your Orthopedic Residency Program Director

\*Last two years of residency
