

MULTIPURPOSE RESIDENT GRANTS

Mid-America Orthopaedic Association



Three grants of \$4,000 each are available for eligible individuals* on a competitive basis for a variety of possible uses.

The grant may be used to fund a "visiting residency", educational trip abroad, research project, or any other educational activity which the resident might wish to propose. A list of the programs participating in the visiting residencies may be obtained from the Mid-America office (address below).

Residents receiving awards must use the funds within the academic year in which it is awarded and will be invited to the first Mid-America Orthopaedic Association annual meeting after the project is completed. He/she will be introduced to the membership and asked to describe his/her experience with a brief illustrated presentation.

Please be advised that these funds may be considered taxable income. It is recommended that a tax accountant be consulted on this matter.

Applications must be received by **July 1, 2010.**

*Orthopedic residents must be in their third, fourth, fifth, or sixth postgraduate years, not a research or fellowship year, and be located in the 20-state Mid-America region. Former recipients of a Mid-America Orthopaedic Association Multipurpose Resident Grant are not eligible.
