2019-2020 TRAVELING FELLOWSHIP

1. Two Traveling Fellowships up to a maximum of \$5,000 each will be awarded.
2. Applicant must submit:
 - a. Letter of intent to include how this fellowship will affect/improve your practice. Fellowship must be done at an institution in the MAOA 20-state area.
 - b. Proposed itinerary to include institution name, supervising/sponsoring M.D., and timeline
 - c. A letter of support from your Department Chair
 - d. A letter of support from a colleague who knows you well
 - e. Copy of curriculum vitae
3. Criteria:
 - a. Applicant must be a member of the MAOA or have applied for membership by July 1, 2019.
 - b. Applicant must be under age 45 by date of application deadline (**July 1, 2019**).
 - c. Applicant must be a United States citizen or have applied for U.S. citizenship.
 - d. Applicant must be Board-certified.
 - e. Applicant must maintain a practice and be currently located in, and the fellowship must be done at an institution in the following states:
Alabama, Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, or Wisconsin.
 - f. If selected, recipient is expected to submit a written report after completion of the fellowship and attend the next annual meeting to give a brief report to the Association. The annual meeting registration will be waived for the recipient and guest.

Please be advised that these funds may be considered taxable income. It is recommended that a tax accountant be consulted on this matter.
